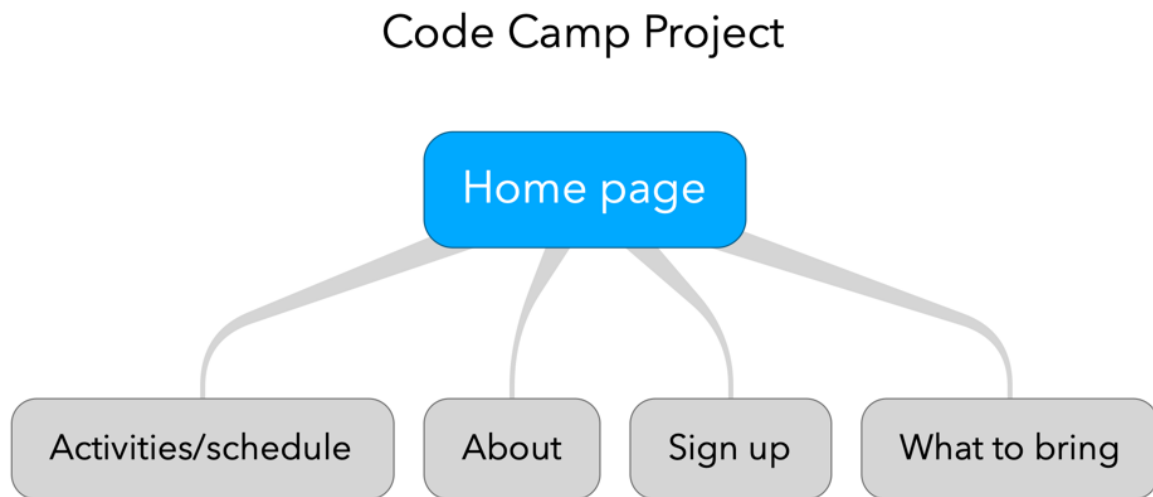


THE CODE CAMP PROJECT PART 1
